Outside:

The Catlin Avenue/Main Entrance parking loop will remain closed through next week. The student parking lot, adjacent to 28th street, will lose between 15 and 30 parking spots. This is necessary to accommodate re-routing of pedestrian traffic off of the current 28th street side-walk. The 28th street side-walk, located along side high school property, will be closed to create a safe zone for operation of heavy equipment and construction vehicles.

Inside:

Demolition inside of the locker rooms is scheduled to begin on May 1. For safety reasons, the hallways located on the 28th street side of the pool and between the locker rooms and the gym will be closed.

Thank you for patience and understanding as the construction activity picks up.
